DATE: Friday 6th March

TIME: 10.00am to 2.00pm

VENUE: Craigie Leisure Centre – outdoor 50m pool

DRESS: Faction colours, bathers suitable for competition, hat and thongs. Students will also be required to bring a bag with goggles, sun cream, water bottle, recess and lunch.
Please make sure all items are clearly labelled with your child's name.

PARENT HELP:

For this carnival to go ahead, I will need many parent volunteers for the day. Please contact me or complete the **parent helper form** if you can assist in any of these areas.

Roles will include:

Life guards – parents in the water ready to assist.

Starters assistants – lining students up ready for their events.

Finishing marshals – collecting children from the pool and directing them to scorers.

Judging – assisting teachers in placing of students.

Recorders – recording race results.

Ribbons – assisting in handing out ribbons to place getters.

WHAT NEXT:

Students will receive a **nomination form** where they will choose what races they would like to compete in, a **permission form** to attend the event and a **water based excursion form**. These **3 forms** are due back to school no later than **Friday 14th February 2020** so events can be prepared. Attendance and participation at the carnival is compulsory and students are expected to compete in at least 1 event.

Additional information, such as programme of events, movement to and from the carnival will be provided closer to the day.
